3. Approval of Minutes from 3-10-22 – On a motion by Kristi Wilson and a second by Rachel Oates, the Council voted unanimously to approve the Minutes from the 3-10-22 School Site Council meeting.
4. Discussion
 - a. Review and Revise Comprehensive School Safety Plan - Updates need to be made to the Comprehensive School Safety Plan reflecting modifications due to school construction. Moving forward, are we going to continue the ALICE protocol? If so, we need to train staff. In years past we have had an Emergency Flip Chart for staff to refer to, it would be helpful if we had that again. Playground needs maintenance, weed block is showing, more wood chips need to be added and cracks need to be filled on the blacktop.
 - b. Share Calendar and Instructional Day Survey Results - The results of the survey indicated that a majority of the people are neutral or favor the “Late Starts”. More discussions need to be had to determine what day of the week the late starts should be on as well as start times.
 - c. LCAP Discussion - Mid-Year Review – The following Positives and Areas of Growth were discussed about the LCAP, Goal 1.

Positives:

 - a. Increase in appropriately assigned teachers 86% to 90% = 4% increase
 - b. Teacher Generated Assessments - Meeting Goal 50% in ELA and 57% in Math
 - c. EL Reclassification Rate 0% to 10.5% = Met Goal of 10% (EL Program)
 - d. Mid-Year Report Fiscal analysis are numbers pulled from 2nd interim 1/31/22. Funds budgeted are on target with numbers seen in the mid-year report w/ increases due to salary increase. Savings in Professional Development

Area of Growth:

 - a. NWEA: Measure of Academic Progress Scores: ELA = 33% (0% increase from last spring) and Math = 29% (2% increase from last spring)
 - b. 2021 ELPAC scores show only 20% made progress towards EL proficiency and Goal is 35%. However, we are hoping to see more growth with a full year of EL program in the 2022 Summative ELPAC scores.
